HISTORY

The 19th Century was a time of great social and political change. There was a revival of Biblical faith. Men and women realised that they had equal rights. One of these rights was to live in a drug-free home. Many women came to see the crippling hold alcohol had on men, in particular. With boldness, groups of women marched on pubs, seeing in them the cause of the low living standards of many women and children.

From this activity and with much prayer, the WCTU was founded in 1874. Members signed a pledge never to use alcohol or drugs and urged others to follow. A white ribbon signified their commitment. A prominent founding member and president, Frances Willard, in the USA, called for total abstinence of both individuals and nations.

The WCTU soon spread throughout the world and thousands of women joined. They campaigned for women's right to vote

and Kate Sheppard, a leader of WCTU New Zealand, led the way when in 1893 they were successful. South Australia was next in 1894 and women were allowed to vote and stand for office in parliament. WCTU has never looked back.
